GASOLINE

- · Store for up to two years
- Treat with a stabilizer for longer life
- Store in a well ventilated place, but not in direct sunlight

DIESEL FUEL

- Store for 6-12 months
- · Treat with a stabilizer for longer life
- Store in a well ventilated place, but not in direct sunlight

KEROSENE

- Store in a different color container Usually gas is red, kerosene is blue
- Store outdoors, but not in direct sunlight

BUTANE

- Can store indoors out of the reach of children
- Withstands a lot of heat, but do not store in direct sunlight

PROPANE

- Do not store in a house or garage
- · Store upright, and on a firm surface
- · Don't store near anything flammable

CHARCOAL

- Can store inside your home, but never cook with charcoal indoors
- Keep it dry; try a bucket or bin

COAL

- · Store indoors or outdoors
- Storing in bags or bins make it easier to carry to the stove

FIREWOOD

- Dry out the wood to encourage most of the bugs to leave the wood
- Store firewood outdoors at least 30 feet away from your house
- Use a tarp to keep it dry

MATCHES

- · Store matches that are waterproof
- Dip them in paraffin to waterproof
- · Keep dry; use baggies or a bucket
- Don't store in direct sunlight
