Find My Past (<u>www.findmypast.com</u>)

<u>Findmypast</u> contains over 2 billion historical records from around the world, however its main focus are for records from:

- British Isles (over 1 billion records available)
- o Ireland
- o Australia
- New Zealand
- Canada and the U.S.

<u>Findmypast</u> also contains a significant number of military records, including US military records from the Revolutionary War through World War II.

In order to access <u>findmypast</u>, after first signing in to FamilySearch.org:

• Click on "Get Help" in the top right hand corner of the page

- Then click "Help Center" on the left hand side of the drop down menu
- On the resulting page, on the bottom of the page, near the center, click "Partners"
- On the next page, click the dropdown arrow to the right of the words "Our Partners"
- There you'll see a list of the available partners, accessible through your FamilySearch access:
 - o Ancestry
 - o MyHeritage
 - o <u>findmypast</u>
 - o Family.me
 - o American Ancestors
 - o Other Partners
- Then click the one you want to sign up for in this case: findmypast
- Follow the instructions listed to sign up for this website and access the great sources there.

On the home page:

- Search: Do search for names you're looking for that you hope to find here
- Family Tree: Allows you to input your family tree. You'll have to create it from scratch, or you can import it to <u>findmypast</u> via a GEDCOM file, which you can generate from FamilySearch
 - Putting your tree into <u>findmypast</u> will allow the database to generate hints tailored to you from indexed records that have similarities to ancestors listed in your tree
- News: Find out what's been added recently to <u>findmypast</u>
- Help: Advice and tips for getting started. Also the FAQ's are listed here.

On the bottom right of the homepage, <u>findmypast</u> has a link titled "Watch us on YouTube," which has over 50 different videos to help you learn more about <u>findmypast</u> and what is available to you there, along with links to share information from <u>findmypast</u> on Facebook and Twitter.
